TOWN COMMITTEES

Currently there are openings on the following (1) Conservation Commission, (2) Council on Aging Board, (2) Agricultural Commission, (1) Board of Assessors, (1) Advisory Board and (4) Cable Advisory Board. These are listed on the Town's website under Volunteer Opportunities.

POLICE

Received notification from Cushing Academy's Chief Financial Officer that their Trustees voted to approve the extension of their financial support of the one full-time police officer through June 30, 2016 (FY16).

TOWN HALL

Reviewing quotes for the town hall step project. I will be establishing a time line for repair. Shed is in process of being erected by Monty Tech students.

VMS BUILDING

We will be looking to clean out the VMS building to get ready for the asbestos remediation. Need to understand how the Board would like to proceed with removing contents.

WATER

Have made initial contact with USDA and discussed with Water and Sewer Commissioners to replace water lines on South Maple, Williams, and Holden Street through one of their grant programs.

PILOT

Working with Town Counsel and Jack Levi from tenK Energy to finalize PILOT agreement.

FIRE

Chief and I will be in negotiations with the Fire Union whose contract expires on June 30th of this year.

SUMMER MEETING SCHEDULE

With the summer months and vacation time coming up the Board needs to consider whether they want to set up a summer schedule for their meetings. In the past few years, the Board has decided on one meeting in the months of July and August, a date in the middle of the month rather than the first or third Monday.
