TOWN COMMITTEES

VMS BUILDING

A complete excess material inventory of the building has been done. I request that the Board vote to categorize these items as excess. WATER

Have made initial contact with USDA and discussed with Water and Sewer Commissioners to replace water lines on South Maple Avenue, Williams Road, Westminster Street and Holden Street through one of their grant programs.

PILOT

Town Counsel is reviewing PILOT verbiage with changes from TenK Energy.

FIRE

Chief and I will be in negotiations with the Fire Union whose contract expires on June 30th of this year.

MEMA

I went with Steve Nims to a briefing on available grants from FEMA/MEMA due by middle of August. Steve and I are looking at several possibilities for these grants, which would include the culvert going under RT 12 by Cushing Street.

DPIR (Distressed Properties Identification and Revitalization) GRANT APPLICATION

I am working with Kevin Flynn of MRPC on this grant which would help with the issue of the collateral effects of foreclosures, reduced property values, vacant and distressed nuisance properties, broken families, damaged neighborhoods, lost municipal revenues and economic distress in the Town of Ashburnham.

As we come to year end I will continue to work with all boards, departments, and committees to ensure a proper closure.
