

Minutes of the Ashburnham Conservation Commission
February 23, 2009

7:30 PM CP opened the Meeting of the Ashburnham Conservation Commission under the Wetlands Protection Act, M.G.L. Ch 131 Sect. 40, and in accordance with the Ashburnham Wetlands Protection Bylaw.

7:31 PM CP opened the Notice of Intent Hearing for Richard and Paula Boutwell for 73 Fitchburg Road. CP asked if there were any abutters present to speak for or against the application: no abutters were present. John Deline of Deline Engineering presented the plans for a septic system upgrade to the Conservation Commission. Mr. Deline explained that this was the only location on the site where the system could be located due to the location of fuel tanks. Silt fence is proposed for erosion control. On the paved areas, the silt fence will be punched through the pavement and crushed stone will be placed at the toe of the fence. LC requested a detail of the erosion control barrier be added to the plan. LC asked if dewatering would be necessary. Mr. Deline did not believe so but noted that the Board of Health requested an LSP submit a plan regarding the construction of the system. The Commission requested the Order be conditioned to adhere to the LSP plan. MD asked whether the LSP will be on site during construction. Mr. Deline said he did not think he would unless something was encountered. The Applicant has requested a continuance from the Board of Health till at least their meeting in April.
