PERMITS TO BE ISSUED ARE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

1. All work to be done in accordance with provisions of the Town of Ashburnham Rules and Regulations and Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 82, Section 40. Trenching permit: All work to be done in compliance with OSHA regulations and Mass Excavation & Trench Safety Regulation 520 CMR 14.00
2. The Highway Superintendent/W/S Foreman must be notified on the day prior to excavation and also on the day prior to resurfacing of openings.
3. Applicants will be required to maintain street openings in accordance with the provisions of the Section 142-24 Construction Standards.
4. Highways Superintendent/W/S Foreman must be notified upon completion of work in order to conduct a final inspection. Highway Superintendent/W/S Foreman reserves the right to change the provisions of the permit to meet existing conditions where public safety and convenience require.
5. Contractors must adhere to Water/Sewer fees & connection regulations and Water /Sewer rules & regulations
6. Contractors MUST complete and turn into office a detailed AS-BUILT within 10 days of completion.

The undersigned applicant agrees to reimburse the municipality for any and all costs and expenses incurred by the municipality in connection with the permit and the work conducted there under, including, but limited to enforcing the requirements of the state law and conditions of this permit, inspections made to assure compliance therewith, and measures taken by the municipality to protect the public where the applicant has failed to comply therewith including police details and other remedial measures deemed necessary by the municipality.

The undersigned applicant agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the municipality and all of its agents and employees from any and all liability, causes or action, and expenses resulting from or arising out of any injury, death, loss, or damage to any person or property during the work conducted under this permit.
