

**PROCEEDINGS OF SPECIAL TOWN ELECTION
HELD ON JUNE 20, 2006**

PURSUANT TO THE FOREGOING WARRANT, THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF ASHBURNHAM MET AT JOHN R. BRIGGS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL GYM, WILLIAMS ROAD, ASHBURNHAM FOR THE PURPOSE OF BALLOTING FOR THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS ON JUNE 20, 2006.

THE POLLS WERE OPEN AT 9:00 A.M. AND CLOSED AT 8:00 P.M. THE RESULTS WERE AS FOLLOWS:

DEBT EXCLUSION #1: Shall the Town of Ashburnham be allowed to exempt from the provisions of proposition two and one-half, so-called, the amounts requested to pay for the bond issued in order to purchase and equip a new fire engine to replace Engine 1?

CAPITAL OUTLAY EXPENDITURE EXCLUSION #1: Shall the Town of Ashburnham be allowed to exempt from the provisions of proposition two and one-half, so called, the sum of \$150,000 to meet Ashburnham's share of the capital expenses of the Ashburnham-Westminster Regional School District for fiscal year 2007?

CAPITAL OUTLAY EXPENDITURE EXCLUSION #2: Shall the Town of Ashburnham be allowed to assess an additional \$170,000 in real estate and personal property taxes for the purpose of reconstruction of town roads and sidewalks for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006?

CAPITAL OUTLAY EXPENDITURE EXCLUSION #3: Shall the Town of Ashburnham be allowed to exempt from the provisions of proposition two and one-half, so-called, the amounts required to pay the Town's apportioned share of the bond issued by the Ashburnham-Westminster Regional School District in order to finance costs of reconstructing, making extraordinary repairs to and equipping the Oakmont Athletic Field, Oakmont Track, and to the extent funds permit, the repaving of Overlook road and parking areas, including the payment of any and all other costs incidental and related thereto ?
