TOWN COMMITTEES

TOWN HALL

Town hall step project will begin the middle of July and will be done by Castle Masonry. The shed is complete. The Monty Tech students did a wonderful job and we are greatly appreciative of their work.

VMS BUILDING

A complete inventory of the building will be done to have BOS review for excess material inventory. Once complete, I propose that we will advertise the list on our town website, and the Town boards and committees, then set a date for a tag sale or on-line bid sale.

WATER

Have made initial contact with USDA and discussed with Water and Sewer Commissioners to replace water lines on South Maple Avenue, Williams Road, and Holden Street through one of their grant programs.

PILOT

Town Counsel is reviewing PILOT verbiage with changes from TenK Energy.

FIRE

Chief and I will be in negotiations with the Fire Union whose contract expires on June 30th of this year.
