TOWN COMMITTEES

Currently there are openings on the following (1) Conservation Commission, (1) Council on Aging Board, (1) Parks and Recreation, (2) Historical Commission. These are listed on the Town's website under Volunteer Opportunities.

ROADS

We are now working to get Holden St, South Maple, Turnpike, completed in June and schedule the summer work of River Styx and Russell Hill.

CONTRACTS

I met with the police union on May 26th and will report at tonight's executive session. I am looking at several dates to start the negotiations with DPW.

BRIGGS SCHOOL

The MSBA Board meeting is June 3rd where they will be voting on our final reimbursement of \$532,373. We will then have a deficit of \$48,489.91 which I will review to cover from transfers from other accounts.

PHONE SYSTEM

The T1 line is in, we are also looking at connecting the municipal grounds building and the light department as well as laying the line for the new DPW location.

DEP

There is a scheduled June 3rd meeting with the DEP to review our unaccounted for water.

CENTER OF TOWN

I met with the old Downtown Focus Committee on May 28th. We will be working to generate a proposed game plan.

SUMMER MEETINGS

With the summer months coming upon us we have over the last several years only met once per month in July and August. I recommend that we do the same this year with meeting dates on the 13th of July and the 17th of August. As always should something come up we can always meet.
